## Indoor air quality monitoring

The workshop presents results of the EU-FP7 project CETIEB "Cost-Effective Tools for Better Indoor Environment in Retrofitted Energy Efficient Buildings" (<a href="www.cetieb.eu">www.cetieb.eu</a>), which aims to develop innovative solutions for better monitoring indoor environment quality and to investigate active and passive systems for improving it. The focus lies on results which are relevant for the use in cultural heritage buildings.
